The Orientation began with a brief inaugural ceremony consisting of Ganesh Vandana. The dignitaries present on the occasion were

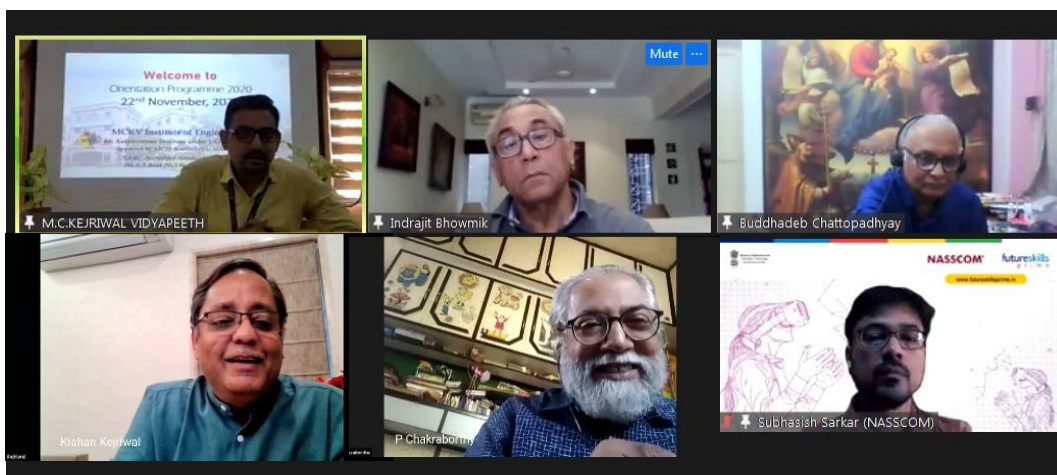
